JOINT MOTION TO AMEND
SCHEDULING ORDER

PacifiCorp, the Division of Public Utilities, the Committee of Consumer Services and the UAE Intervention Group (referred to collectively herein as the “Participating Parties”) hereby request that the Utah Public Service Commission (“Commission”) amend the scheduling order adopted by the Commission in this docket to extend the filing deadline for Intervenor Direct Testimony on test period issues from April 21, 2006 to April 28, 2006 and to establish a five business day response period for data requests regarding test period served on or after April 28, 2006. In support of this motion, PacifiCorp states as follows:

1. On April 4, 2006, the Commission issued a Scheduling Order in this proceeding setting April 21, 2006 as the filing deadline for Intervenor Direct Testimony on test period

issues. The Commission's Order also established a seven business day response period for data requests regarding test period issues served on or after April 21, 2006 and a three business day response period for data requests served on or after May 12, 2006.

2. Pursuant to the Scheduling Order, the Participating Parties and other parties to this case met on April 11, 2006 to discuss test period issues. Based on those discussions, the Participating Parties agree that a change in the procedural schedule is desirable in order to allow additional time to review and discuss test period issues and to engage in settlement negotiations.

3. Therefore, the Participating Parties request that the Commission amend the Scheduling Order to extend the filing deadline for Intervenor Direct Testimony on test period issues from April 21, 2006 to April 28, 2006 and to establish a five business day response period for data requests regarding test period served on or after April 28, 2006.

4. Because the proposed changes to the schedule provide parties with additional time to review and discuss test period issues, it is not anticipated that any of the parties to this proceeding would object to the proposed changes.

WHEREFORE, the Participating Parties respectfully request that the Commission enter an order amending the Scheduling Order in this proceeding as discussed herein.
