NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The following schedule shall apply in this proceeding unless otherwise ordered by the Commission:

Deadline to object to outstanding discovery requests	November 17, 2006
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Deadline to file a motion to compel current discovery requests	November 28, 2006
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Direct testimony on line loss adjustment issue	January 12, 2007
Rebuttal testimony	January 31, 2007
Sur-rebuttal testimony	February 15, 2007
Hearing on line loss adjustment	February 22, 2007 1:30 p.m.

2. The parties shall, if possible, serve all filings and discovery by electronic mail. If any party does not have an electronic mail address or is unable to send documents by electronic mail, service shall, if possible, be by facsimile. If a party has neither an electronic mail address nor a facsimile number or a party is unable to serve documents by electronic mail or facsimile, documents shall be served by hand delivery or overnight courier at the discretion of the serving party. It is understood that attachments or exhibits that are not available electronically and which are too bulky to be served by facsimile will be either hand-delivered or sent by overnight courier to parties who would otherwise be entitled to receive service of them by electronic mail or facsimile.
