Rocky Mountain Power (“the Company”), a division of PacifiCorp, (“RMP” or the “Company”) hereby applies to the Public Service Commission of Utah (“PSCU” or the “Commission”) for an order (1) authorizing the Company to transfer its undepreciated net investment of approximately \$8.9 million in the Powerdale Plant from Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC”) Account 101, Electric Plant in Service, to FERC Account 182.2, Unrecovered Plant and Regulatory Study Costs, (2) permitting the Company to record Powerdale decommissioning costs estimated to be approximately \$6.3 million to FERC Account 182.2 and (3) establish amortization periods for these amounts.
