Interwest Energy Alliance, (“Interwest”) by and through counsel, hereby petitions the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) for intervention in the above-entitled matter pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63-46b-9 and Utah Admin. R746-100-7.

The grounds for this petition are as follows:

1. Interwest is a Colorado-based trade association representing major companies in the renewable energy and energy efficiency industries throughout the United States. In its Application, one of the drivers for Rocky Mountain Power’s (“Rocky Mountain”) proposed rate increase which the parties and the Commission will analyze in this proceeding is the addition of new renewable energy generation resources. This important issue is one in which Interwest has interest and expertise. In addition, Interwest’s members are or will be developing renewable resources in Utah and could provide to Rocky Mountain renewable energy for the benefit of Utah’s electric customers and Utah’s environment. Interwest and Interwest’s members, therefore, have a significant interest in the

above-captioned matter and their legal interests may be substantially affected by the outcome. Interwest could also provide information that would aid the Commission in making some of the decisions it must make in this proceeding.
