Re: Docket No. 07-035-T14 - Solar Photovoltaic Incentive Program (Schedule 107)
Annual Report for Program Year 2009

In Docket No. 07-035-T14, the Commission directed Rocky Mountain Power (“the Company”) to provide an annual report on the Solar Photovoltaic Incentive Program to the Commission, Division, Office and DSM Advisory Group no later than March 1st through the duration of the program’s five-year pilot term. The report is to contain, at a minimum, information on completed projects, program expenditures and recommendations for the upcoming year.

Rocky Mountain Power has been working with the program administrator, Ecos Consulting, to gather and compile project information necessary to complete the 2009 report from customers who participated in the 2009 program. Program participants have until January 31st of the following year in which their project was approved for program participation to complete their project, have their project inspected and submit all required information to the Company. As part of this process, the program administrator reviews and approves the final installation, including equipment ratings, and completes an on-site inspection which includes photo documentation of the project. After the project is inspected, the program administrator reconciles final invoices submitted by the participant to determine installed system costs. While projects close throughout the year, the closing of many projects occur near or even after the January 31st completion deadline. This trend has continued throughout the 2009 close process, with the program administrator having approximately ten inspections and project reconciliations remaining at this time.

In order to allow the program administrator sufficient time to close the remaining projects and gather the project information necessary to generate a complete 2009 program report, Rocky Mountain Power respectfully requests an extension of the March 1st due date of this report and permission to file the report no later than March 15, 2010.
