In its August 3, 2007 order in Docket No. 07-035-T14, the Public Service Commission of Utah (the "Commission") directed Rocky Mountain Power (the "Company") to "provide a report within three years assessing whether changes are warranted in any element of the Program" at page 8. The Company is currently working on the ordered report, including compiling data and performing the analysis necessary to make the assessment directed in the order.
