INTRODUCTION

On April 4, 2007, PacifiCorp, doing business in Utah as Rocky Mountain Power ("Company"), filed with the Utah Public Service Commission ("Commission") a request for approval of Schedule 107 - Solar Incentive Program ("Program"). The Program is a five-year pilot program providing financial support to those customers who purchase and install solar photovoltaic systems. In its August 3, 2007, order, the Commission approved the Program and directed the Company to "provide a report within three years assessing whether changes are warranted in any element of the Program" at page 8.

On July 21, 2010, the Company filed a letter with the Commission requesting the Commission grant an extension to file the assessment report to September 30, 2010. The Company explained it is currently working on the ordered report, including compiling data and performing the analysis necessary to make the assessment directed in the order. However, the Company, anticipates it will take up to an additional 60 days to complete the analysis. No objections to the requested extension were filed.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the requested extension for filing of the assessment report to September 30, 2010, is hereby granted.
