Utah Public Service Commission,

I would like to thank Rocky Mountain Power and the Commission on their work on making the pilot program. Its great to see efforts being made in making a sustainable utility grid. Along with that, thanks for the opportunity to take public comment on next steps for such a program.

Creative Energies is an environmentally based company that designs and installs solar electric grid tie systems. We have been in business for 10 year operating in Idaho and Wyoming. This spring we opened our third office in Salt Lake City. Rocky Mountain Power informed us recently that Lander or main office with a population of 6000 has more net metering customer than any other place they serve in Wyoming. This type of impact could not have happened with out subsidies from the State, Federal, and Rocky Mountains blue-sky grant. If Rocky Mountain Power would expand it program in the region, Salt Lake City could be the leader in net meeting in the Rocky mountain region. These programs help support jobs, the environment and Rocky Mountain Power. I urge the commission to reinstate the incentive and expand it.
