)	Motion for Entry of a Procedural Schedule
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Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp, (“Rocky Mountain Power” or “PacifiCorp”), hereby moves the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) for entry of a procedural schedule in the above captioned proceeding. In support of this Motion, Rocky Mountain Power states as follows:

1. On November 4, 2008, Rocky Mountain Power submitted an application to the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) for entry of an accounting order authorizing the Company to record a net reduction to the regulatory asset associated with the existing pension and other postretirement welfare assets for a pension curtailment gain, and a measurement date change transitional adjustment, effective as of the filing date.
2. On November 5, 2008, the Commission sent an Action Request to the Utah Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) seeking an explanation and discussion of the issues to be addressed in connection with the November 4, 2008 filing.

3. On November 13, 2008, the Division recommended that the Commission schedule a technical conference, allow intervenor testimony, and hold a hearing on the application in early January 2009.

4. On November 25, 2008, the Commission held a technical conference during which the Division, Committee of Consumer Services, and the Company discussed the filing and agreed to the following procedural schedule:

December 18, 2008	Deadline for Intervenor Testimony to be filed.
December 23, 2008	Settlement Conference
December 30, 2008	Deadline for Exhibits to be filed
January 6, 2009	Public Hearing.

5. There are currently no additional parties that have intervened in the case, and the Company, Division and Committee have all agreed that the above schedule will allow development of a full record and provides sufficient time for all parties to develop their case.

WHEREFORE, Rocky Mountain Power respectfully requests entry of the above procedural schedule.
