By The Commission:

On February 27, 2008, PacifiCorp d/b/a Rocky Mountain Power (“Petitioner”) submitted Advice No. 08-01 regarding proposed revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 110. According to the Advice, this program, called the Energy Star Homes Program (“Program”), is expected to further enhance the energy efficiency of new home construction; delivering improved home performance, comfort and savings. Petitioner has requested an effective date of March 28, 2008, for these tariff revisions.

The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) was asked to investigate this application and filed a memorandum on March 25, 2008, recommending the Commission approve the requested tariff revisions. The Committee of Consumer Services filed a memorandum on March 26, 2008, recommending approval subject to some suggested modifications.

After examination of the filings in this Docket, the Commission has identified additional concerns that have not been addressed and therefore suspends the proposed tariff revisions. The existing tariff shall remain in force.

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ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the proposed Pacificorp d/b/a Rocky Mountain Power tariff revision filing be and it is suspended pending further Order of the Commission.
