RE: Tariff 08-05 Docket No. 08-035-T05 Rocky Mountain Power is proposing changes to Electric Service Regulations 2 (General Definitions), 4 (Supply and Use of Service), 5 (Customer's Installation) and 12 (Line Extensions).

Dear Ms. Son:

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff revisions transmitted with your Advice Letter No. 08-05 dated July 15, 2008.

The Division of Public Utilities was asked to investigate this application and filed a memorandum on August 6, 2008, recommending the Commission approve the requested tariff revisions if additional changes are made. The Committee of Consumer Services filed a memorandum on August 7, 2008, recommending, as well, approval subject to suggested modifications. The Commission will suspend the tariff revision in order to allow the company time to review the suggested modifications and provide a response on whether the company agrees with the suggested changes or reasons why they should not be adopted. The Commission as well has some question whether the changes would constitute a 'rate increase,' as defined in Utah Code Section 54-7-12 (1)(b).

Therefore, the revisions, are suspended pending further action from the Public Service Commission.
