ORDER

Based on the discussion of those in attendance, the following is set as the scheduling order in this matter:

**If U.S. Mag. and RMP Reach a resolution, the date they will file the stipulated contract with the Commission, together with supporting testimony** Thursday, August 13, 2009

**If U.S. Mag. and RMP fail to reach a resolution, the date they will submit the contract terms to which they have agreed together with any disputed terms, together with testimony supporting each party's position** Thursday, August 13, 2009

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<b>Filing date for Division and OCS testimony, if required</b>	Thursday, November 5, 2009
<b>Filing date for rebuttal testimony from all parties, if required</b>	Wednesday, November 25, 2009
<b>Hearing date; any sur-rebuttal testimony may be provided at the hearing, if required</b>	Wednesday, December 2, 2009 and Thursday, December 3, 2009 before the ALJ of the Public Service Commission, and commencing each day at 9:30 a.m., Room 451, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, UT 84111

Discovery turn-around is 14 calendar days for discovery conducted on or before November 5, 2009, and 7 calendar days for discovery conducted after November 5, 2009.
