On May 13, 2009, the Division of Public Utilities filed a request to change the current schedule on test period issues in this case to extend the filing date for rebuttal testimony due May 14, 2009 to noon on May 19, 2009. The Commission granted the scheduling change in the Scheduling Order issued May 14, 2009. In its request to change this date, the Division of Public Utilities represents that the Division of Public Utilities, the Office of Consumer Services, UAE Intervention Group, and Rocky Mountain Power (Parties) have reached a tentative settlement agreement regarding the appropriate test year for this proceeding. On May 14, 2009, Rocky Mountain Power filed a Motion for Approval of Test Period Stipulation and a Test Period Stipulation and requested a hearing on the stipulation to be held on May 21, 2009 at the time originally scheduled for the test year hearing.

Based upon these requests, the schedule is modified as follows and notice is hereby given:

1. Test Period Rebuttal Testimony due May 19, 2009 is hereby suspended, and testimony in support of the Stipulation shall be presented live at the hearing.
2. The Commission will conduct a hearing on the Stipulation on **Thursday, May 21, 2009, at 2:30 p.m., Fourth Floor Room 403**, Heber M. Wells State Office building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah, to consider approval of the Test Period Stipulation filed by Rocky Mountain Power on May 14, 2009.
