Re: Notice of Intent to File General Rate Case and Request for Approval of Test  
Period

The Stipulation Regarding Revenue Requirement in Docket 08-035-38 was filed on March 23, 2009, and presented at hearing on March 31, 2009. Paragraph 15 of that stipulation states that PacifiCorp will “File a notice of intent to file the next rate case at least 30 days prior to the expected date of such filing.” Rocky Mountain Power hereby provides notice of its intent to file a general rate case. Consistent with the Commission’s Order on Motion for Approval of Test Period (Order) in Docket No. 08-035-38, Rocky Mountain Power intends to file its “other material (e.g., revenue requirement information, rate proposals and rate schedules and tariffs)” on or about June 15, 2009.

Consistent with the Commission’s Order, by this letter, Rocky Mountain Power also provides notice that it proposes to use a twelve month ending December 31, 2010, forecast test period in the “other materials” to be filed on or about June 15, 2009. The Company requests that the Utah Commission approve the proposed test period. The Company respectfully requests that the Commission set a procedural schedule that will provide a decision on the test period to be used in this case by May 15, 2009, which will enable the Company to finalize the revenue requirement and complete the preparation of the other materials in order to file by June 15, 2009.

The attached document provides Rocky Mountain Power’s summary support and justification for a forecasted test period ending December 31, 2010.
