Utah Clean Energy (“UCE”) respectfully petitions for leave to intervene in the above-captioned docket. While this intervention comes at a late date, we respectfully request that UCE’s intervention in this docket be granted. We incorrectly understood that there would be a second intervention deadline for parties interested primarily in the second phase of the rate case. In support of the abovementioned intervention UCE states as follows:

1. Utah Clean Energy (UCE) is a state-based non-profit public interest group working to advance energy efficiency and renewable energy, and the economic and environmental benefits those resources provide, in the public policy and utility regulatory arenas in Utah. Through advocacy, education, and diverse partnerships, UCE advances renewable energy and energy efficiency. UCE partners with businesses, state and local government, and Utah citizens to support the adoption of clean energy and the efficient use of our energy resources.

2. UCE has a substantial interest in the above-captioned proceeding, primarily in the second phase dealing with rate design. Rate design can encourage energy

efficiency and conservation, and impact resource planning decisions. By its intervention, UCE intends to address rate design issues that impact energy efficiency and conservation.

3. Intervention by UCE will not unduly broaden the issues or delay the proceeding. While our intervention is being filed late, our primary interest is in the second phase of the rate case, still to come. UCE does not currently know what evidence, if any, it would present in this proceeding.
