Thank you for your letter dated January 25, 2010 wherein you raised a concern regarding the error in the labor adjustment in RMP’s June 2009 application. My staff has reviewed the information you provided and we confirm that the Commission’s staff has appropriately calculated the Company’s surrebuttal position if the correction is made.

There is a very small effect on the payroll taxes not included in the Commission staff’s calculation that amounts to less than \$1,200. Due to the immateriality of this effect, we recommend no adjustment be made for it.
