My husband and I are residents of Elk Ridge in Tooele, Utah.

We are both adamantly opposed to transmission lines under consideration (Section 190 eastward to the Tooele County Line, Map Figure 2-3 April 2009). This affects the lives of those in the area in so many derogatory ways.

Specific reasons for our opposition:

- Endangerment of our watershed
- Endangerment of the prolific wildlife in the area
- Potential health risks to children especially, but also to adults in the area
- Scarring and defacement of the mountains and foothills
