**RE: Compliance Filing of Electric Service Schedule No. 37, Avoided Cost Purchases From Qualifying Facilities (Docket 09-035-T14)**

On August 4, 2009, Rocky Mountain Power filed an update to the avoided cost pricing in Schedule No. 37, Avoided Cost Purchases from Qualifying Facilities. On September 30, 2009, the Commission issued an order not approving the rates as filed. In that order, the Commission directed Rocky Mountain Power to provide additional information and clarification and refile as necessary within two weeks Schedule No. 37 rates and tariff sheets. On October 21, 2009 the Company filed revised Schedule No. 37 rates and tariff sheets. On December 14, 2009 the Commission approved the filing with adjustments noted in the order and directed Rocky Mountain Power to file rates and tariff sheets as specified in the order. This filing is in compliance with the December 14, 2009 order.

Enclosed for filing are an original and two copies of proposed tariff sheets associated with Tariff P.S.C.U No. 47 of PacifiCorp, d.b.a Rocky Mountain Power, applicable to electric service in the State of Utah. Pursuant to the requirement of Rule R746-405D, Rocky Mountain Power states that the proposed tariff sheets do not constitute a violation of state law or Commission rule.
