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Pursuant to the Utah Code Ann. § 63G-4-207 and Utah Admin. Code § R476-100-7 and § 63-46b-9, Qwest Corporation (“Qwest”) respectfully petitions to intervene in the above-referenced proceeding before the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”). As grounds for such intervention, Qwest states that it has legal rights or interests that are or may be substantially affected by these proceedings, that there are facts which support this position detailed below, and that Qwest requests that it be allowed intervention.

In support of this Petition, Qwest states as follows:

1. As a provider of telecommunications services, video services, and broadband services in Utah, Qwest is attached to slightly more than 44,000 poles in Utah that are owned by Rocky Mountain Power. As such, Qwest is directly impacted by the Application of Rocky Mountain Power, which could potentially result in cost increases or delays. Thus, Qwest’s legal interests would be substantially and directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding.

2. The interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of this proceeding will not be materially impaired by allowing Qwest to intervene.
