Pursuant to Rule 14-806 of the Utah Code of Judicial Administration, Keith Hamilton, a United States Air Force Reserves (USAFR) attorney, sponsoring local Utah counsel, moves the Utah Public Utilities Commission for an order admitting Ms. Karen S. White, a United States Air Force civilian attorney for The Federal Executive Agencies (FEA), and out of state counsel, pro hac vice to act as counsel in the above-captioned matter as an intervening party.
