ORDER SCHEDULING
SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY IN TEST
YEAR INQUIRY PHASE

ISSUED: March 8, 2011

By The Commission:

In a Scheduling Order dated February 23, 2011, the Commission specified the schedule for this proceeding, including the schedule for the Test Period Inquiry Phase. The purpose of that phase is to determine whether the Applicant's chosen test period, or an alternative, meets the standard set forth in Utah Code § 54-4-4(3). The Commission has received a recent question concerning whether surrebuttal testimony will be permitted in the Test Year Inquiry Phase. This Order clarifies for all parties that the Commission will not receive surrebuttal testimony presented orally, i.e., on the witness stand. **Parties, however, may offer written surrebuttal testimony that has been filed with the Commission and served on all parties no later than Monday, March 21, 2011.** This testimony must be prepared and served in conformance with the requirements set forth in the February 23, 2011, Scheduling Order.
