Subject: Application of the Utah Association of Energy Users for a Deferred Accounting Order directing Rocky Mountain Power to Defer Incremental REC Revenue for Later Ratemaking Treatment, Docket No. 10-035-14.

Date: February 25, 2010

Utah Association of Energy Users (UAE) in its Application for a Deferred Accounting Order for Incremental Renewable Energy Credits (REC) Revenue has requested that the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) require Rocky Mountain Power (Company) to defer for later ratemaking treatment all REC revenue in excess of the REC value utilized in Utah rates.

UAE filed its Application with the Commission on February 22, 2010. The Commission then issued an Action Request for the Division on the same day. Further discovery will be needed to establish whether this issue may qualify for deferred accounting treatment. In response to the Action Request, the Division requests that the Commission set a Scheduling Conference at the earliest opportunity. The Division will participate according to the Scheduling Order.
