Enclosed please find an Application for Conditional Use Permit (CUP) submitted on behalf of Rocky Mountain Power. Rocky Mountain Power files this CUP application understanding that transmission lines and substations are permitted conditional uses in conformance with Tooele County text amendment #09-04300002 provisions, which include modifications to the MG-EX zone and conditional use permit height allowances as requested. This application seeks approval from Tooele County in order to construct a new double-circuit 345 kilovolt (kV) transmission line, in conformance with Tooele County land use ordinances. If the Planning Commission makes further modification to the ordinance, Rocky Mountain Power is prepared to amend this application to conform to those modifications.
