Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63G-4-207 and Utah Admin. Code § R746-100-7, Integra Telecom of Utah, Inc., Electric Lightwave, LLC, and Eschelon Telecom of Utah, Inc. (collectively “Integra”) hereby moves for leave to intervene in the above-referenced proceeding before the Public Service Commission of Utah. In support of this Motion, Integra states as follows:

1. Rocky Mountain Power requested an order under Utah Admin. Code R746-345-3 approving a standard form Non-Reciprocal Pole Attachment Agreement (the “Agreement”) to be utilized between Rocky Mountain Power and cable and/or telecommunications companies desiring to attach facilities to the Rocky Mountain Power’s distribution poles on or about April 26, 2010.

2. Integra is a competitive local exchange carrier certified by the Public Service Commission of Utah to provide telecommunications services in the State of Utah.

3. Integra has thousands of pole attachments with Rocky Mountain Power in the State of Utah.

4. Integra's customers in Utah may be impacted by Integra's ability to attach to Rocky Mountain Power's poles upon just and reasonable rates, terms, and conditions.

5. The interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of this proceeding will not be materially impaired by allowing Integra to intervene.
