) ORDER CONSOLIDATING  
) APPLICATIONS AND SECOND  
) AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER

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ISSUED: September 20, 2010

By The Commission:

On April 27, 2010, PacifiCorp, a utility doing business in Utah as Rocky Mountain Power (“Company” or “RMP”), filed its Application for Approval of Standard Non-Reciprocal Pole Attachment Agreement. The Commission opened Docket No. 10-035-43 for the purpose of examining this application.

On August 3, 2010, the Commission issued an amended scheduling order in Docket No. 10-035-43. Consistent with that order, the Company filed its Application for Approval of Standard Reciprocal Pole Attachment Agreement on August 31, 2010, and moved to consolidate the two applications.

The Company’s motion to consolidate is unopposed and likely will result in more efficient consideration of the two applications. Accordingly, the motion to consolidate is granted. The two applications will be processed in a new docket, Docket No. 10-035-97, captioned as follows: “In the Matter of the Consolidated Applications of Rocky Mountain Power for Approval of Standard Reciprocal and Non-Reciprocal Pole Attachment Agreements.”

Consolidation of these two applications necessitates adjustments to the previously-ordered schedule. In particular, parties need an opportunity to comment on the proposed standard reciprocal pole attachment agreement filed on August 31, 2010. Accordingly, **the Commission amends the August 3, 2010 scheduling order to provide parties until October 5, 2010 to comment on the reciprocal agreement.** To the extent feasible, the second issues matrix scheduled to be filed by the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) on October 11, 2010 will include issues pertaining to both the non-reciprocal and reciprocal agreements. **The reciprocal agreement will be addressed at the October 18, 2010 technical conference, if time permits.** Additional technical conferences will be scheduled at that time, as necessary.

To serve as a reference point for examining the reciprocal agreement, the Commission directs the Division to file a redline version of the previously-approved Safe Harbor Agreement showing all differences between it and the proposed reciprocal agreement. This redline version shall be filed by September 27, 2010. It will be similar in form to the redline version the Division previously filed pertaining to the non-reciprocal agreement.

**ORDER**

The following schedule reflects the forgoing adjustments, is otherwise unchanged from the August 3rd order, and is hereby established:

<b>Tuesday, September 21, 2010</b>	Deadline for filing interventions and for intervenors to file responsive comments to RMP’s August 31, 2010, comments.
<b>Monday, September 27, 2010</b>	DPU files redline version of Safe Harbor Agreement reflecting the proposed Standard Reciprocal Pole Attachment Agreement.

<b>Monday, October 4, 2010</b>	Technical Conference to consider Statement of Generally Available Terms or Standard Contract Template, in connection with RMP's proposed Standard Non-reciprocal Pole Attachment Agreement. <b>The conference will start at 1:30 p.m. in Room 401</b> , Heber M. Wells State Office Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah, followed by a scheduling conference if needed.
<b>Tuesday, October 5, 2010</b>	Deadline for intervenors to file responsive comments to RMP's August 31, 2010 proposed Standard Reciprocal Pole Attachment Agreement.
<b>Monday, October 11, 2010</b>	DPU files second issues matrix (including issues pertaining to the reciprocal agreement).
<b>Monday, October 18, 2010</b>	Technical Conference to finalize issues. The conference will be held from <b>10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. in room 401</b> , Heber M. Wells State Office Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah, followed by a scheduling conference if needed.

When parties make filings with the Commission, they shall serve an electronic copy of such filings on other parties. Any filings made with the Commission shall also be accompanied by an original and five hard copies. Parties shall serve discovery requests and responses on applicable parties electronically.

Individuals wishing to participate by telephone should contact the Commission at least two business days prior to the conference to make arrangements. On the day of the conference, participants must call (801) 530-6716 or call toll-free 1-866-PSC-UTAH (1-866-772-8824) at least five minutes prior the beginning of the conference to ensure participation.
