Re: Demand-side management reports pursuant to Commission order in Docket No.
09-035-T08

In its order in the above referenced docket dated August 25, 2009, the Commission approved the Phase I stipulation agreed to by parties in that docket and filed with the Commission on August 3, 2009. As specified in the stipulation, Rocky Mountain Power (the "Company") is required to provide to the Commission and Demand-Side Management Advisory Group ("Advisory Group") by November 1 of each year a forecast of expenditures for approved programs and their acquisition targets (in MWh and MW) for the next calendar year. A report containing the forecast of these items for calendar year 2011 is provided as Attachment 1.

The stipulation also requires the Company to provide to the Commission and Advisory Group on a semi-annual basis a Utah DSM tariff rider balancing account analysis similar to that originally provided by the Company in Advice No. 09-08. Pursuant to this condition, the Company has provided such analyses to the Commission and Advisory Group in November 2009 and April 2010. The Company also provided a supplemental tariff rider analysis on September 30, 2010. The tariff rider analysis provided as Attachment 2 reflects actual results through September 2010 and projects Utah DSM expenditures and Schedule 193 revenues through August 2011. Consistent with the analysis submitted on September 30, 2010, the analysis in Attachment 2 shows that the balance in the Utah DSM balancing account is expected to reflect an over collection of approximately \$10.8 million as of August 2011.

To align Schedule 193 revenues with projected expenditures, the Company is preparing a filing to reduce the Utah DSM tariff rider collection rate to become effective January 1, 2011. This filing will be submitted to the Commission shortly.
