By The Commission:

The Commission held a duly noticed scheduling conference on April 2, 2012, to determine the process and schedule for examining the application of Rocky Mountain Power (“RMP” or “Applicant”) for approval of proposed changes to the “Safe Harbor” pole attachment agreement adopted by the Commission in docket No. 04-999-03. In addition, the application seeks approval of various non-recurring fees.

At the scheduling conference, the parties agreed that a technical conference will take place on **Thursday, April 26, 2012, beginning at 2:00 p.m., in Fourth Floor Room 401, Heber Wells Bldg., 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.** At the conference, RMP will present information in support of its application. The presentation will also include RMP’s answers to parties’ questions about the application. Parties are invited to serve such questions on RMP, and file them with the Commission, not later than April 13, 2012. On or before April 23, 2012, RMP will distribute to all parties, and file with the Commission, an outline of its presentation.

On Tuesday, June 5, 2012, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Fourth Floor Room 401, Heber Wells Bldg., 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah, the Commission will hold

a second scheduling conference to receive recommendations concerning the further processing of this application.

For discovery requests served on and after April 3, 2012, responses shall be served within fourteen calendar days. Where feasible, parties shall serve discovery requests and responses on applicable parties by electronic mail.
