Re: In the Matter of the Consolidated Applications of Rocky Mountain Power for Approval of Standard Reciprocal Non-Reciprocal Pole Attachment Agreements (Docket No. 10-035-97, formerly Docket No. 10-035-43)

RECOMMENDATION: No action is required. The attached matrix contains issues that will be discussed by the parties at the October 4, 2010 Technical Conference.

DISCUSSION

On April 27, 2010, Rocky Mountain Power (“Company”) filed with the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) an Application for Approval of a Standard Non-Reciprocal Pole Attachment Agreement (“Agreement”) in Docket No. 10-035-43. On June 30, 2010, the Company filed Supplemental and Clarifying comments to further explain the nature of the Company’s Application and to include exhibits that were inadvertently omitted from the initial filing.

The Commission held a Scheduling Conference on July 29, 2010 and issued a Scheduling Order on August 3, 2010. The Commission issued an Amended Scheduling Order on September 20, 2010, that consolidates Docket No. 10-035-43 into a new docket with the Company’s August 3, 2010 Application for Approval of a Standard Reciprocal Agreement (Docket No. 10-035-97).

This memo pertains to the non-reciprocal agreement.

Consistent with the Commission's Scheduling Order, the Division is charged with compiling a matrix of issues identified by interested parties. Attached to this memo is the DPU issues matrix with respect to non-reciprocal pole attachment agreements. The matrix will be used to facilitate discussion by the parties, including the Division, of the issues at the October 4, 2010 Technical Conference. No action is required by the Commission at this time.
