In this docket the Commission is examining applications filed by PacifiCorp, a utility doing business in Utah as Rocky Mountain Power (“Company”), for approval of standard pole attachment agreements.

On October 4, 2010, the Commission convened a duly noticed technical conference to consider issues pertaining to the Company’s proposed standard non-reciprocal pole attachment agreement. Following the Company’s presentation and a lengthy discussion of issues, the Company expressed a desire to re-assess and clarify its objectives in this docket. Accordingly, the Commission, with the parties’ agreement, hereby suspends the remaining schedule in this docket, previously ordered on September 20, 2010. The suspension will be in effect until further order of the Commission.
