RE: Rocky Mountain Power Advice Letter 10-04, Schedule 135 Net Metering Service Docket No. 10-035-T04, "Pursuant to page 24 of the Commission order received on February 12, 2009 in Docket 08-035-78, the Company submits the average retail rates for the previous year's Federal Energy Regulation Commission Form No. 1 for the valuation of net excess generation credits for large non-residential customers and submits further changes to its Schedule 135 in accordance with recent interconnection rules adopted in R746-312 clarifying aggregation and when a disconnect switch is required."

Dear Mr. Taylor:

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff revisions transmitted with your Advice Letter No. 10-04 dated May 26, 2010.

The Division, in its Memorandum dated June 22, 2010, recommends the Commission accept the revisions to the above named tariff. During review, however, the Commission identified an incorrect reference to the newly adopted Electrical Interconnection Rule (UAC R746-312) in Special Conditions 6 on Sheet 135.5. The correct reference is R746-312-4(2) (a) (ii).

Now therefore, the revisions, with an effective date of July 1, 2010, with the correction indicated above, are approved by the Commission.
