Re: Advice No. 10-13
Schedule 193 – Demand Side Management (DSM) Cost Adjustment

On December 9, 2010, Rocky Mountain Power (the “Company”) submitted Tariff Advice No. 10-13, which proposed a reduction to the Schedule 193 collection rate. Certain information was inadvertently omitted from the proposed tariff sheet (Seventh Revision of Sheet No. 193.2) which accompanied that filing. Specifically, the proposed tariff sheet omitted references to Schedules 40, 97 and 98. The inclusion of these schedules in the application of Schedule 193 is necessary to collect the level of Schedule 193 revenue proposed by the Company. Also, the proposed changes to the tariff sheet were marked using an incorrect symbol as specified in R746-405-2(3). The attached tariff sheet corrects these issues.
