SECOND JOINT MOTION FOR AN ORDER EXTENDING THE TIME TO RESPOND TO UIEC'S MOTION TO DISQUALIFY

The Utah Industrial Energy Consumers ("UIEC"), PacifiCorp d/b/a Rocky Mountain Power ("Company"), the Division of Public Utilities, the Office of Consumer Services, and the Utah Association of Energy Users ("UAE") (collectively, the "Parties") hereby jointly move the Commission for an order extending for an additional sixteen (16) days the time in which the parties have to respond to UIEC's Motion to Disqualify or, in the Alternative, to Require the Development of Models to Assist the Commission in Evaluating the Proposals of All of the Parties ("Motion to Disqualify"), which was filed with the Commission on June 1, 2012. The grounds for this Joint Motion are as follows:

1. The UIEC filed the Motion to Disqualify on June 1, 2012. Pursuant to the provision at R746-100-4(D), responsive briefs were originally due on June 18, 2012. In response

to a Joint Motion for an Order Extending the Time to Respond to UIEC's Motion to Disqualify, which was filed by the undersigned Parties on June 13, 2012, the Commission, on June 14, 2012, issued an Order Extending the Time to Respond until July 18, 2012.

2. The Parties had originally requested additional time so that they could participate in a Settlement Conference, the purpose of which was for Dr. Jim Logan to provide clarification on certain aspects of an integrated model that he developed for Commission staff, and to review and clarify issues raised in the Commission's May 10, 2012 Action Request to the Division of Public Utilities.

3. As the discussions related to the integrated model are still ongoing among the Parties, by this Second Joint Motion, the Parties request that the Commission postpone for an additional sixteen (16) days, until August 3, 2012, the deadline for the Parties to file briefs in response to UIEC's Motion to Disqualify.


