By The Commission:

In our order of August 8, 2012, we set for hearing the Settlement Stipulation (the “Stipulation”) filed on August 7, 2012 by PacifiCorp (dba in Utah as Rocky Mountain Power), the Division of Public Utilities, the Office of Consumer Services and several other parties. As noted in that order, the Stipulation is offered to resolve most, if not all, requests for relief and related issues pending in the three above-captioned dockets. The Stipulation hearing¹ will begin with presentations of testimony and exhibits by proponents of the Stipulation. Parties opposing any aspect of the Stipulation who intend to present testimony shall file, **not later than August**

20, 2012, a brief statement specifying the issues they intend to raise and the witnesses they intend to call.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Our order of August 8, 2012 also rescheduled the Public Witness hearing, previously scheduled for August 29, 2012. We repeat that the Public Witness hearing addressing these three dockets and, in particular, the Stipulation has been rescheduled to 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 21, 2012, in Fourth Floor Hearing Room 403, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah. This hearing will end when individuals present at the beginning have finished their comments. The Commission may limit presentations of testimony or comments that are unduly repetitious. Any individual wishing to present a statement to the Commission that is unable to do so during the Public Witness Day hearing may file a written statement with the Commission at its offices: Fourth Floor, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah 84111 in person, by mail, by electronic mail to tbehr@utah.gov, or by facsimile to (801) 530-6796. Please indicate that the statement pertains to Docket Nos. 11-035-200, 12-035-79 and 12-035-80.
