By The Commission:

The Commission held a duly noticed scheduling conference in the above-entitled matter on May 4, 2011. Based on the discussion at the conference, the schedule presented in the table, below, is established provisionally for this proceeding. The schedule is contingent on the Commission's forthcoming decision on the motion of PacifiCorp ("Company"), doing business in Utah as Rocky Mountain Power, to dismiss the application.

<b>Hearing</b>	<b>Monday, October 17, 2011, 9:00 a.m., Room 403, Heber M. Wells Bldg., 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City.</b> Note: If a second hearing day is required, it will take place beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 18, 2011.

If the Company's motion is denied, parties shall file testimony with the Commission in accordance with the foregoing schedule and shall follow the procedures set forth at "PSC Filing Requirements" under the "MISC." tab on the Utah Public Service Commission website homepage. Additionally, written testimony and other exhibits offered into evidence shall conform to Utah Administrative Code R746-100-10.F.2. In particular, they shall adequately explain: "Explicit and detailed sources of the information contained in the exhibit; methods used in statistical compilations, including explanations and justifications; assumptions, estimates and judgments, together with the bases, justifications and results; formulas or algorithms used for calculations, together with explanations of inputs or variables used in the calculations." Parties shall serve copies of all filings on other parties by electronic mail at or before the time an electronic copy of the document is filed with the Commission.

Additionally, please note the scheduled hearing dates are one week later than contemplated at the scheduling conference due to a conflict.

### **DISCOVERY**

Responses to discovery requests served within the following time frames shall be provided within the designated number of days:

Until July 26, 2011, within 21 calendar days.

After July 26, 2011, and until September 20, 2011, within 14 calendar days.

After September 20, 2011, and until October 4, 2011, within 7 calendar days.

After October 4, 2011, within 5 calendar days.

Discovery requests may be served while the motion to dismiss is pending; however, no responses will be required unless and until the motion is denied. Should the motion be denied, any requests

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served while the motion is pending shall be due within five calendar days of the denial or on the due date under the foregoing schedule, whichever is later.

Parties shall serve discovery requests and responses on applicable parties by electronic mail. In the event a document filed with the Commission or produced in response to a discovery request cannot reasonably be transmitted by electronic mail, the party filing the document shall file an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy) with the Commission by hand delivery and shall serve an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy) on each applicable party by hand delivery if the party being served is in the same metropolitan area as the serving party, or by overnight courier if the party being served is located in a different metropolitan area from the serving party.

Individuals wishing to participate in any hearing by telephone should contact the Public Service Commission two days in advance by calling (801) 530-6716 or (toll-free) 1-866-PSC-UTAH (1-866-772-8824). Participants attending by telephone should then call the Public Service Commission five minutes prior to the conference to ensure participation.
