Re: Docket No. 11-035-74 - Addendum filing of Rocky Mountain Power's Utah Demand-Side Management Annual Report for 2010

On September 12, 2011, Rocky Mountain Power (the Company) filed an Addendum to its Utah Energy Efficiency and Peak Reduction Report (the Report) for 2010 with the Public Service Commission of Utah (the Commission), which was originally submitted on April 7, 2011. This addendum was filed in response to the Commission's order in the above referenced docket dated July 14, 2011, directing the Company to file an addendum clarifying certain elements within the Report. On October 19, 2011, the Commission issued a letter to the Company stating that revisions made in the September 12, 2011, addendum concerning the valuation of megawatt savings as reported in Tables 1 and 2 of the Report (as found on pages 5 and 6 of the Report, respectively) did not fully address the Commission's direction concerning this matter; the Commission directed the Company to file again an addendum to the Report more fully clarifying the determination of megawatt savings as reported in Tables 1 and 2 of the Report.

In response to the Commission's direction, the Company has modified the Report, which is provided herewith, to include additional information on how the megawatt savings as reported in Tables 1 and 2 are quantified. The modifications include moving megawatt valuation explanations from the body of the report to a newly created Appendix 2 which addresses capacity estimates provided in the Report for both load management and energy efficiency programs. Rocky Mountain Power believes the information provided in Appendix 2 to the Report addresses the Commission's direction concerning this matter.
