RECOMMENDATION (Approval)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) approve Rocky Mountain Power's (Company) proposed tariff revisions to Schedule 107, Solar Incentive Program filed with the Commission on February 24, 2011 as compliant with the Commission Order of February 10, 2011.

ISSUE AND DISCUSSION

On February 10, 2011, in Docket No. 07-035-T14, the Commission issued an Order acknowledging the Company's Three Year Assessment of the Solar Incentive Program, Schedule 107. In this Order, the Commission directed the Company, among other things, to reduce the solar incentive level from \$2 per watt to \$1.55 per watt.

In compliance with this Commission Order, on February 24, 2011, the Company filed its proposed tariff revisions to Schedule 107, Sheet Nos. 107.2 and 107.3. The Division reviewed these tariff revisions and determined that they are in compliance with the above-mentioned

Commission Order. Therefore, the Division recommends that the Commission approve the revised Tariff Sheets, Sheet Nos. 107.2 and 107.3, as compliant with the Commission Order.
