Re: 11-035-T03 – Schedule 114 - Cool Keeper Program

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## **RECOMMENDATION (Approval)**

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) approve Rocky Mountain Power's (Company) proposed modifications to the Cool Keeper Program tariff (Schedule 114).

## **ISSUE AND DISCUSSION**

On May 16, 2011, the Company filed its comments in response to the April 27, 2011 Commission Order in this Docket. In this filing the Company responded to the Comments of the Division and the Office of Consumer Services (Office). On May 24, the Division and the Office filed their responses to the Company's comments recommending that the Commission accept the new proposed tariff language and/or alternate language. However, the Office proposed an alternate language intended to clarify the partial use provision. After several informal discussions with the Division and the Office, the Company proposed the following language which was agreed to by the Division and the Office.

Program participation may be denied to customers whose Qualifying Equipment is not regularly in operation during the Summer Peak Period at the discretion of the Company despite meeting all other Program requirements for participation.

On June 9, 2011, the Company filed its proposed modifications to the Cool Keeper program that contains the proposed language under the Application section. Therefore, the Division concludes that this filing is in compliance with the Commission Order dated April 27, 2011 and recommends that the Commission approve it.
