ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

ISSUED: July 27, 2011

By The Commission:

On June 28, 2011, PacifiCorp, d/b/a Rocky Mountain Power, submitted Advice Letter No. 11-06 regarding an annual update for Schedule 37, Avoided Cost Purchases From Qualifying Facilities (QF). This tariff modification goes into effect on July 28, 2011, unless suspended by the Commission.

The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) was asked to investigate this issue and on July 21, 2011, filed a memorandum requesting additional time for review until July 28, 2011, thereby leaving no time for review by the Commission and other interested parties prior to the date the tariff would otherwise become effective. Based upon the Division’s request for additional time and the time necessary for others to review the Division’s recommendation, the Commission will suspend the tariff filing pending the results of the Division’s investigation and Commission review. Based upon the comments received, the Commission will determine whether a formal hearing will be necessary prior to issuing the final order in this matter.

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ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the proposed Pacificorp d/b/a Rocky Mountain Power tariff filing be and is suspended pending further Order of the Commission.
