RECOMMENDATION (Approval)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) approve Rocky Mountain Power's (Company) proposed modifications to the Low Income Lifeline Program tariff (Schedule 91) with an effective date of October 4, 2011.

ISSUE AND DISCUSSION

On September 1, 2011, the Company filed its modified tariff pages for Schedule 91, "Surcharge To Fund Low Income Residential Lifeline Program," with the Commission under P.S.C.U. No. 47. A Commission hearing was held on October 4, 2011, in which advice No. 11-07 was approved effective October 4, 2011. On September 13, 2011, the Company received an order from the Commission in Docket No. 10-035-124 approving a new tariff book P.S.C.U. No. 48, effective September 21, 2011. The Division reviewed the modified Low Income Lifeline Program tariff pages for accuracy, thoroughness, and compliance with the September 13, 2011

Commission Order. The Division concludes that this filing is in compliance with the Commission Order dated September 13, 2011 and recommends that the Commission approve it.
