Dear Ms. Son:

On September 12, 2011, PacifiCorp, dba Rocky Mountain Power, (Company) filed a letter with the Commission, Advice No. 11-08, stating its intention to cancel Tariff P.S.C.U. No. 47, Electric Service Schedule No. 97, "Major Plant Additions Deferral Rider," (Schedule 97) effective September 8, 2011. Pursuant to Docket No. 10-035-89, Schedule 97 is to terminate when the deferred revenue from Docket No. 10-035-13, plus carrying charges, has been collected from customers. In Advice No. 11-08, the Company represents the account balance will be close to zero in early September. Thus, the Company intends to apply Schedule 97 to customer usage through September 8, 2011, and terminate Schedule 97 on that date.

The Company also states a final reconciliation of this deferral account will occur in October when meter readings and customer bills for all usage through September 8, 2011, are completed. The Company will refund or collect any over-recovery or under-recovery of the Docket No. 10-035-13 deferral account through another mechanism to be proposed at a later date. The Company will combine the true-up of the collections under Schedule 97 with any reconciliation and true-up of Electric Service Schedule No. 40, "Major Plant Additions" (Schedule 40). The Company proposes terminating Schedule 40 effective September 21, 2011, in accordance with Advice No. 11-09, in Docket No. 11-035-T09.

On September 20, 2011, the Utah Division of Public Utilities (Division) filed with the Commission its recommendations on Advice No. 11-08. The Division states it has reviewed the filing and recommends the Commission acknowledge termination of Schedule 97 as requested

by the Company and supports the Company's proposal to the combined true-up of Schedule 97 and Schedule 40 collections at a later date.

Based on the Company's representations and the Division's review, the Commission acknowledges the cancellation of Schedule 97, effective September 8, 2011. The Commission also supports the Company's proposal to address any reconciliation and true-up of Schedule 97 and Schedule 40 collections in a future filing.
