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**RESIDENTIAL SERVICE**

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**AVAILABILITY:** At any point on the Company's interconnected system where there are facilities of adequate capacity.

**APPLICATION:** This Schedule is for alternating current electric service supplied at approximately 120 or 240 volts through one kilowatt-hour meter at a single point of delivery for all service required on the premises for residential purposes.

**MONTHLY BILL:**

Customer Charge:

\$60.00 per Customer

Energy Charge:

Billing Months - January through December inclusive

34.00¢ per kWh ALL kWh

**CONNECTION FEE:** Each time a Customer, eligible to receive electric service under this Schedule, begins to receive electric service at a point of delivery not previously used, or at a point of delivery which has been used previously by another Customer, or each time a Customer changes his point of delivery or reconnects after voluntary disconnection to the same point of delivery, that Customer shall be charged a connection fee of \$120.00 in accordance with Schedule 4.

**ELECTRIC SERVICE REGULATIONS:** Service under this Schedule will be in accordance with the terms of the Electric Service Agreement between the Customer and the Company. The Electric Service Regulations of the Company on file with and approved by the Public Service Commission of the State of Utah, including future applicable amendments, will be considered as forming a part of and incorporated in said Agreement.

**ELECTRIC SERVICE SCHEDULE NO. 2**

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**COMMERCIAL (SMALL) SERVICE**

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**AVAILABILITY:** At any point on the Company's interconnected system where there are facilities of adequate capacity.

**APPLICATION:** This Schedule is for alternating current electric service supplied at approximately 120 or 240 volts through one kilowatt-hour meter at a single point of delivery for all service required on the premises for commercial purposes. Commercial (Small) are define as those businesses both profit and non-profit, & government entities that use less than 2000 kWh average on the system per Month, reviewed January 1 each year.

**MONTHLY BILL:**

Customer Charge:

\$260.00 per Customer

Energy Charge:

Billing Months - January through December inclusive

34.00¢ per kWh ALL kWh

**CONNECTION FEE:** Each time a Customer, eligible to receive electric service under this Schedule, begins to receive electric service at a point of delivery not previously used, or at a point of delivery which has been used previously by another Customer, or each time a Customer changes his point of delivery or reconnects after voluntary disconnection to the same point of delivery, that Customer shall be charged a connection fee of \$520.00 in accordance with Schedule 4.

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**COMMERCIAL (LARGE) SERVICE**

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**AVAILABILITY:** At any point on the Company's interconnected system where there are facilities of adequate capacity.

**APPLICATION:** This Schedule is for alternating current electric service supplied at approximately 120 or 240 volts through one kilowatt-hour meter at a single point of delivery for all service required on the premises for commercial purposes. Commercial (Large) are define as those businesses both profit and non-profit, & government entities that use greater than 2000 kWh average on the system per Month, reviewed January 1 each year

**MONTHLY BILL:**

Customer Charge:

\$2000.00 per Customer

Energy Charge:

Billing Months - January through December inclusive

34.00¢ per kWh ALL kWh

**CONNECTION FEE:** Each time a Customer, eligible to receive electric service under this Schedule, begins to receive electric service at a point of delivery not previously used, or at a point of delivery which has been used previously by another Customer, or each time a Customer changes his point of delivery or reconnects after voluntary disconnection to the same point of delivery, that Customer shall be charged a connection fee of \$4000.00 in accordance with Schedule 4.

**ELECTRIC SERVICE REGULATIONS:** Service under this Schedule will be in accordance with the terms of the Electric Service Agreement between the Customer and the Company. The Electric Service Regulations of the Company on file with and approved by the Public Service Commission of the State of Utah, including future applicable amendments, will be considered as forming a part of and incorporated in said Agreement.

**ELECTRIC SERVICE SCHEDULE NO. 4**

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**CONNECTION CHARGES**

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**AVAILABILITY:** At any point on the Company's interconnected system where there are facilities of adequate capacity.

**APPLICATION:** This Schedule is for alternating current electric service supplied at approximately 120 or 240 volts through one kilowatt-hour meter at a single point of delivery for all service required on the premises for residential or commercial purposes.

**CONNECTION FEE:**

Customer Charge:

\$120.00 per Residential Customer per connection incident

\$520.00 per Commercial (Small) Customer per connection incident

\$4000.00 per Commercial (Large) Customer per connection incident

**NEW CONNECTION FEE:** Each time a Customer, eligible to receive new electric service under this Schedule, begins to receive electric service at a point of delivery not previously used, that Customer shall be charged a new connection fee of \$500.00.

**ELECTRIC SERVICE REGULATIONS:** Service under this Schedule will be in accordance with the terms of the Electric Service Agreement between the Customer and the Company. The Electric Service Regulations of the Company on file with and approved by the Public Service Commission of the State of Utah, including future applicable amendments, will be considered as forming a part of and incorporated in said Agreement.
