RATE:

Rate for a light installed on an existing pole of sufficient height belonging to the Cooperative where 115 volt un-metered service is available:

175-watt mercury vapor, existing and installed, per lamp per month @

\$21.08 I

175 watt mercury vapor lights are not available for new installations.

100-watt high-pressure sodium, per lamp per month @

\$15.35 I

250-watt high-pressure sodium, per lamp per month @

\$30.10 I

INSTALLATION FEE:

100-watt high-pressure sodium, per installation @

\$500.00

250-watt high-pressure sodium, per installation @

\$600.00

If applicant requests the lighting be placed at some other location than above-described, the Cooperative will prepare an estimate of the total costs of constructing the necessary facilities. These costs will include all costs related to the construction including but not limited to engineering, right-of-way costs, labor, material, and overheads. The Applicant will be required to pay the estimated cost as a non-refundable aid-to-construction payment. After payment of the estimated cost, the Cooperative will then construct the line extension and place the necessary poles to the location selected by Applicant. The said line extension will remain the property of the Cooperative.
