Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63G-4-201, 203 and Utah Admin. Code R746-100-3, Rocky Mountain Power (the “Company”) respectfully requests that the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) approve of its agreement with the City of Enterprise, Utah (“City”) and Leslie A. Barlow (“Customer”) whereby the Company consents to City serving the Customer’s electric load that is located within Rocky Mountain Power’s certificated service territory (“Agreement”). In support of this petition, the Company states as follows:

1. Rocky Mountain Power is a public utility in the state of Utah and is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction with respect to its electric service to retail customers in Utah. Rocky Mountain Power's principal place of business in Utah is 201 South Main Street, Suite 2400, Salt Lake City, UT 84111.

2. City is a municipal provider of retail electric service within the municipal boundaries of the City.

3. Customer has requested service from City to the residence (“Residence”) located at or near 99 North 100 West Enterprise, Utah 84725. The Residence is located within the certificated service territory of Rocky Mountain Power and outside the municipal boundaries of the City. A map showing the approximate location of the Residence in relation to the closest City facilities and the closest Rocky Mountain Power facilities is attached as Exhibit A.

5. City currently has in place distribution facilities located approximately 15 feet from the Residence. City has estimated the Customer cost to extend its facilities to the Residence, to be \$6,400.

6. Rocky Mountain Power currently has in place distribution facilities located approximately 2,000 feet from the Residence. Rocky Mountain Power has estimated the Customer cost to extend its facilities to the Subject Property, to be about \$15,000.

7. As an accommodation to the Customer and the unique circumstances and conditions associated with the provision of retail electric service to the Residence, Rocky Mountain Power, City, and Customer entered into the Agreement, whereby the parties agreed that Rocky Mountain Power shall permit City to serve the Residence in Rocky Mountain Power's certificated service territory, within the limitations identified in the Agreement. The Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

8. City and Customer have each authorized Rocky Mountain Power to represent to the Commission that they join with Rocky Mountain Power in requesting approval of the Agreement between the parties at the Commission's earliest convenience.

9. The petition is based upon the unique circumstances and conditions associated with the location of the Residence the Customer request. Accordingly, pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R746-100-3, the parties hereby petition the Commission for approval of the Agreement, and Commission approval that City be permitted to provide electric service to Customer and that Rocky Mountain Power be permitted to not provide electric service to the Residence located within the Rocky Mountain Power certificated service territory in Enterprise, Utah subject to the other terms and conditions of the Agreement.

WHEREFORE, Rocky Mountain Power, City, and Customer respectfully request that the Commission approve the attached Agreement permitting City to serve the Residence within Rocky Mountain Power's certificated service territory upon the terms and conditions of the Agreement.
