The Commission order approving the tariff sheet modifications directed the Company to further modify tariff language consistent with the recommendations made by the Division of Public Utilities and Office of Consumer Services. Following those recommendations to use the terminology “program effective period” consistently throughout the tariff, all occurrences of the term “irrigation season” have been replaced with “program effective period.” In addition, the referenced year in tariff sheet 96.4 has been changed to 2012 to reflect the current period and the term “Fixed Monthly Participation Credit” has been replaced with “Fixed Annual Participation Credit” in sheet 96.1.
