Re: Tariff Compliance Filing, Docket No. 12-035-T05, Advice No. 12-06 – Changes to Schedule 96A Dispatchable Irrigation Load Control Credit Rider Program and Phase Out of the Schedule 96 Irrigation Load Control Credit Rider Program. Division's Recommendation – Approval.

RECOMMENDATION (Approval)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) approve Rocky Mountain Power's (Company) proposed changes to Schedule 96 and Schedule 96A, with an effective date of May 20, 2012.

ISSUE AND DISCUSSION

On May 21, 2012, the Company filed its revised Utah Tariff Schedule 96 (Schedule Forward Program) and Schedule 96A (Dispatchable Program). On May 16, 2012, the Commission issued its order in the above referenced docket approving the tariff sheet modifications and that the Company further modifies the tariff language with the recommendations made by the Division and Office of Consumer Services (Office) and file corrected tariff sheets for compliance review. The Company replaced all occurrences of the term "irrigation season" with the recommended terminology of "program effective period." The Office recommended that the referenced year in

tariff sheet 96.4 be changed to 2012 and the term “Fixed Monthly Participation Credit” is replaced with “Fixed Annual Participation Credit” in sheet 96.1. The Division concludes that the tariff sheets filed on May 21, 2012 are in compliance with the Commission Order dated May 16, 2012 recommends that the Commission approve them.
