## **RECOMMENDATION (Approval)**

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) approve Rocky Mountain Power's (Company) proposed changes to Schedule 110, with an effective date of July 1, 2012.

## **ISSUE AND DISCUSSION**

On July 5, 2012, the Company filed its revised Utah Tariff Schedule 110 (New Homes Program). On June 27, 2012, the Commission issued its order in the above referenced docket approving the tariff sheet modifications and that the Company further modifies the tariff language with the recommendations made by the Office of Consumer Services (Office) and file corrected tariff sheets for compliance review. The Company removed the ENERGY STAR program name designation on tariff sheets 110.2 and 110.4 and changed the submission requirement date on tariff sheet 110.4 to January 1, 2013. The Division notes that there were some annotation discrepancies on the tariff sheets, but the tariff sheets submitted comply as ordered. The

Division concludes that the tariff sheets filed on June 5, 2012 are in compliance with the Commission Order dated June 27, 2012 recommends that the Commission approve them.
