On August 20, 2012, Rocky Mountain Power filed proposed changes to the Home Energy Savings Incentive Program (Home Energy Savings) administered through Schedule 111. Both the Division of Public Utilities and the Office of Consumer Services recommended approval of the proposed tariff changes, but noted in their comments that the CFL incentive for Daylight (4500 + Kelvin), the LED incentives, and the self install Wall Insulation incentive proposed by the Company were not included in the filed tariff sheets. In response to those recommendations the following corrections have been made to the enclosed tariff sheets:

- The reference to “Daylight” has been added to the second group of CFLs listed in Table 1 on Sheet 111.3.
- LEDs have been added the 2nd to last item in Table 1 on Sheet 111.3.

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- Self-install wall insulation has been added to two different spots in Table 1 on Sheet 111.4.
- Table 1 has been reformatted on Sheet 111.5.
