RE: TARIFF ADVICE 12-14, PROPOSED REVISIONS TO ELECTRIC SERVICE SCHEDULE NOS. 70, RENEWABLE ENERGY RIDER – OPTIONAL AND 72, RENEWABLE ENERGY RIDER – OPTIONAL BULK PURCHASE OPTION.

Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp, hereby files Tariff Advice 12-14 for electronic filing with the Utah Public Service Commission requesting authority to update the Company's Electric Service Schedule Nos. 70, Renewable Energy Rider – Optional and 72, Renewable Energy Rider – Optional Bulk Purchase Option.

The Company is proposing to update the Application section of tariff sheets 70.1 and 72.1 as follows:

- 1. Remove references to specific schedules;
- 2. Add language that encompasses all of the Company's customer schedules for tariff sheet 70.1 and all of the Company's non-residential customer schedules for tariff sheet 72.1.

The Company's intent has always been to make the Blue Sky programs available to all of its electric service customers. Since the Company's tariff schedules are subject to change, the current language in the above referenced Application sections of tariff sheets 70.1 and 72.1 unintentionally excludes the customers on new rate schedules. The proposed modification makes the Blue Sky program available to all customers and removes the administrative burden of constant review of the Company's rate schedules for additions and removals.

Rocky Mountain Power hereby submits a clean and legislative copy of Sheet Nos. 70.1 and 72.1 containing the proposed revisions and respectfully requests Commission approval of these tariff modifications with a November 2, 2012 effective date.
