Re: 13-035-01 (11-999-05) Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Utah Service Reliability Performance Baseline

Pursuant to the rule on service reliability and continuity requirements, R746-313, Rocky Mountain Power ("Company") filed with the Commission its proposed Utah Service Reliability Performance Baseline. On January 7, 2013, the Commission issued an Action Request asking the Division to review the Company's application and make recommendations. The Commission also asked the Division to report back by February 6, 2013.

The Division reviewed the Company's application and found out that the Company has proposed baselines and notification targets for the SAIDI and SAIFI. It also outlined the methods used to determine these baselines and notification targets. The Division had concerns about the methods proposed to be used in the determination of both the baselines and the notification targets. On February 4, 2013, the Division discussed these concerns with the Company. Consequently, the Company decided to revise its

application and re-file it with the Commission. Thus, the Division will need to comment on the Company's revised application.

Therefore, the Division requests that the Commission extend the response date of the Action Request from February 6, 2013 to March 6, 2013. This will allow time for the Company to complete its revisions and the Division to properly study and comment on the Company's revised application.
