Dear Ms. Saba:

The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) reviewed the February 25, 2019 depreciation compliance filing (2019 Filing) by PacifiCorp. The 2019 Filing was made pursuant to PacifiCorp's depreciation rate reporting system implemented in accordance with paragraph 30 of the settlement stipulation approved on November 7, 2013, in the above-referenced docket. Notably, the 2019 Filing lists seven coal units being evaluated for possible early retirement, namely: Cholla Unit 4, Colstrip Units 3 and 4, Craig Unit 1, Craig Unit 2, Jim Bridger Unit 1, and Jim Bridger Unit 2. The 2019 Filing also notes the current repowering of existing wind facilities and the extension of their depreciable lives.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on March 15, 2019. The DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the 2019 Filing as satisfying the PSC-accepted reporting system requirements.

Based on the PSC's review of the filing and the recommendation of the DPU, the PSC acknowledges PacifiCorp's 2019 Filing as complying with the PSC-approved depreciation rate reporting system requirements.
